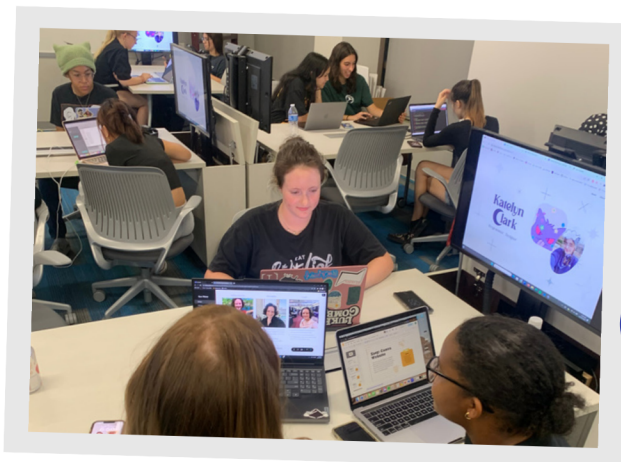
TAMU Gardens Volunteering

Recipe of the Month: Gwyneth's Pumpkin Muffins

Make the most of pumpkin season with this classic recipe made even better with Gwyneth's special recipe tweaks. Enjoy alone or with cinnamon butter.

Ingredients:

- 15 oz pumpkin puree
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, melted
- 3/4 cup light brown sugar
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp pure vanilla extract
- 1 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 1/2 fine sea salt
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.
2. Grease a standard 12-cup muffin tin.
3. In a small bowl, mix together flour, spices, baking powder and sea salt. Set aside.
4. In a large bowl whisk together pumpkin puree and melted butter until smooth.
5. Add brown sugar and granulated sugar and whisk until combined and there are no lumps.
6. Add eggs and vanilla and stir to combine.
7. Add dry ingredients and stir until batter is smooth.
8. Pour 1/4 cup of the pumpkin muffin batter into each well of the muffin tin, and smooth out the top.
9. Bake in preheated oven for 20-25 minutes, or until the tops are set and a cake tested inserted into the center of the loaf comes out clean or with a few crumbs.
10. Let pumpkin muffins cool in the pan on a wire rack for 10 minutes, then remove them and transfer muffins to a wire rack to cool completely.
